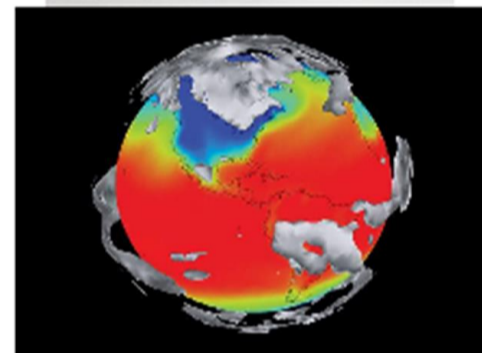

As we gradually get back to "normal life" and safely enjoy each other's company, we hope to invite you all for

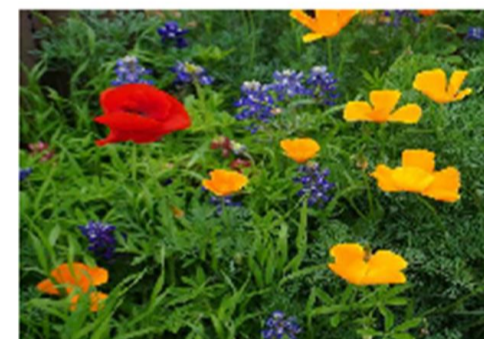
